Financial Aid Clearinghouse - Comprehensive searchable database of financial assistance that is available to residents of the lower Delmarva Peninsula seeking to improve and advance their education. DEF helps people find money to continue their education. Our Financial Aid Clearinghouse, accessible from our website (www.delmarvaed.org), links to sources of local, state, and federal money for education. It includes information on more than 800 priority scholarships, meaning they are sponsored locally and were established to benefit local citizens. These scholarships provide financial aid for individuals including graduating high school seniors, high school graduates returning to school, college undergraduates, and graduate students wishing to further their education and/or skills.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 71,735 including grants of \$ 0) (Revenue \$ 55,447)
DEF-CCAP (College/Career Access Program) - To facilitate access to career, higher education, and financial aid information for local students. DEF's College and Career Access Program is helping boost the college going potential and career preparation of local youth. DEF-CCAP services are offered at presentations throughout our region, and by our advisors in our office and at select high schools through funding from donors and partnerships. DEF-CCAP advisors help with college selection, admission, financial aid, scholarships, and career preparation to guide students through a maze of requirements and choices, providing encouragement and an understanding of how post secondary education or training may benefit each student's life.

Educational Networking - To host networking meetings to connect regional educators, e.g. DEF's Educator Relations Advisory Committee. DEF provides a forum for developing and sharing ideas that relate to improving educational opportunities for the region, particularly regarding access and quality. Our Rural Education Symposium, for example, was followed by a forum on place-based learning and another on financial aid, all targeted to professionals in the education field.
